


Labour Market Information (LMI) is the facts and figures behind jobs and provides useful information including but not limited to the entry routes, prospects, salaries, working hours, skills and qualifications needed for jobs and careers. Crucially, LMI also covers future demand therefore it can be used to examine what jobs and skills will be in demand in a certain number of years hence pupils can prepare themselves for these changes.

The Careers section on the Hodge Hill College website contains the Careerometer which is an online data portal, developed by the UK Commission for Employment and Skills, which brings together existing national sources of high quality LMI helping to inform pupil's choices about their careers.
