Birmingham Council's holiday club programme- BRING IT ON BRUM

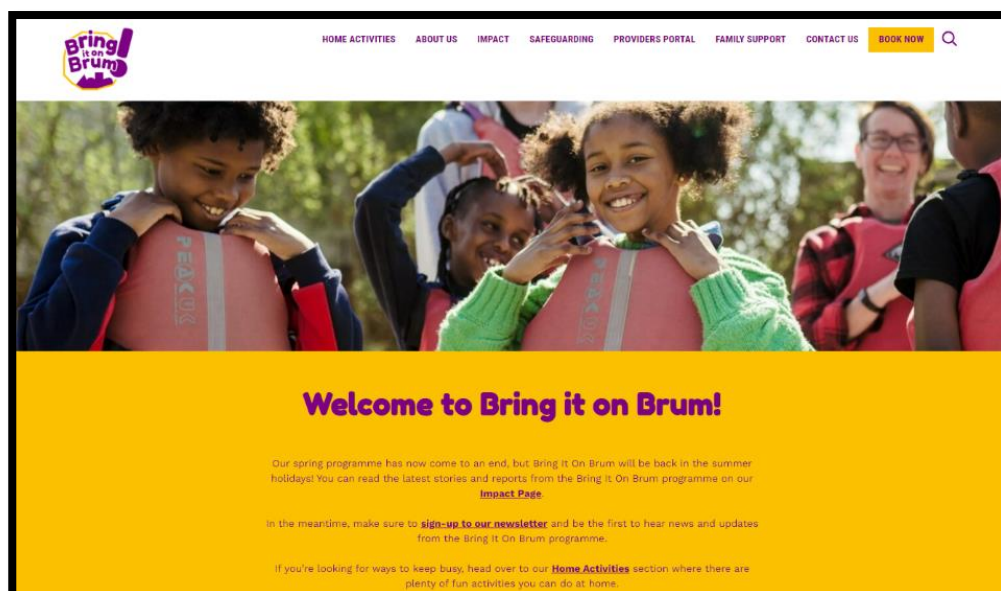

Bring it on Brum! is a programme funded by the Department for Education designed for families in Birmingham to help children, young people and their parents have fulfilling, active, fun-filled and healthy school holidays.

Bring it on Brum! holiday clubs are designed for children who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals. Schools will issue a Bring it on Brum! code to each eligible child. Your family residents will be asked to confirm this code when they register. They need to contact their children school if they have not received the code.

The booking for the summer holiday clubs will start from the 2nd of July 2023, and your family residents need to undertake the activity via the website. You need to contact the company directly with any enquires.

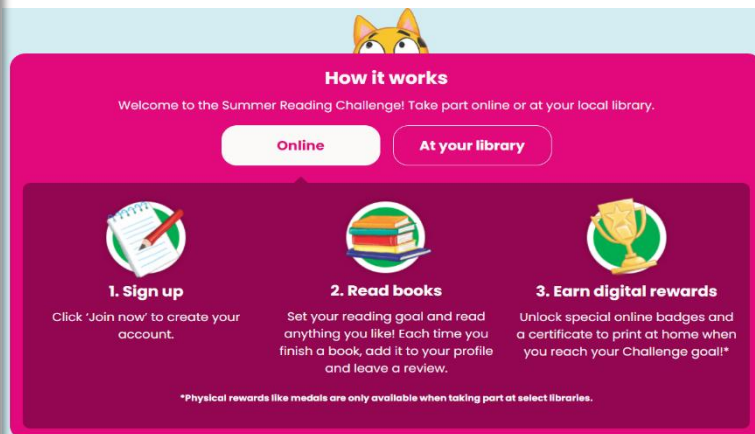
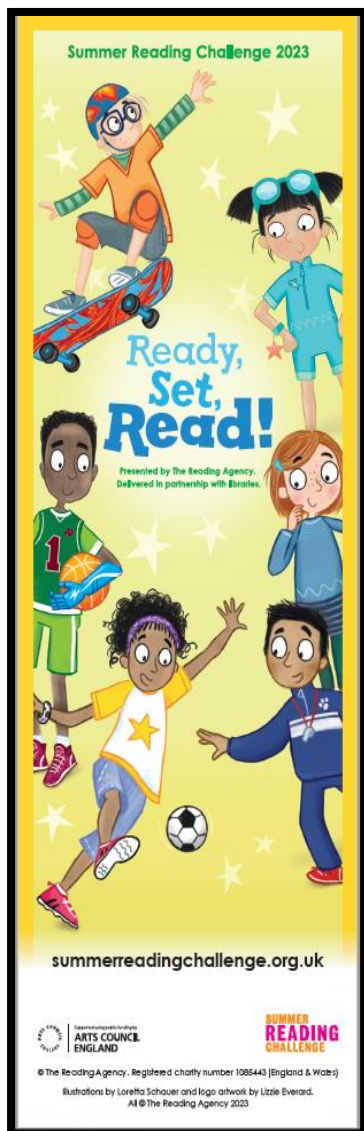
There are additional free childcare and play related resources on the website which parents can use to entertain their children during the summer holiday period.

The aim of the challenge is to encourage children to read a number of books during the summer holiday period. They can either register online, or visit their local Birmingham lib to find out more about the activity and to register.

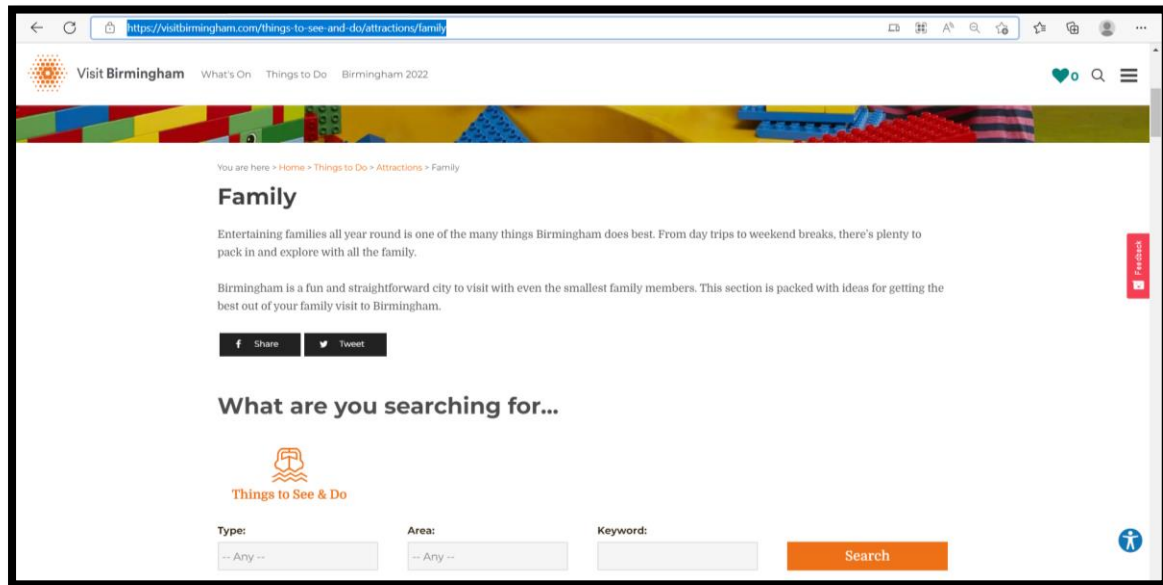

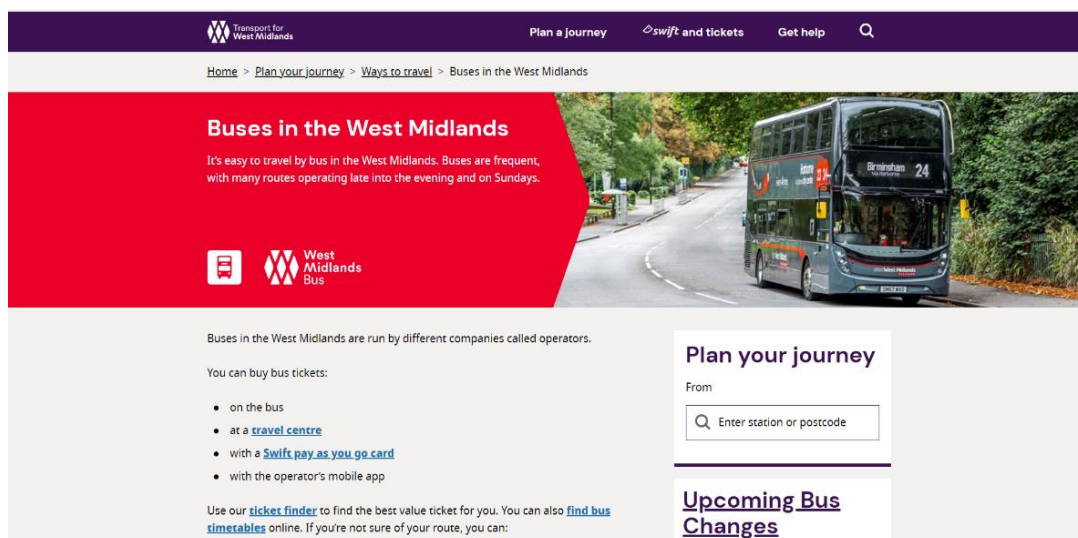
