GCSE Photography Study Visit to Elvaston Castle

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of your child's GCSE Photography course, the Photography department is running an external study visit to Elvaston Castle, Derbyshire, which your child must attend to develop their GCSE coursework portfolio.

This educational visit aims to help students develop real-world skills whilst using a DSLR camera, whilst allowing students to develop their understanding of photographic processes. Students will be able to take an excellent variety of images that can be utilised to create outcomes. These images and outcomes will contribute to the development of their GCSE coursework portfolio.

This will be a day packed with exploration of the country park and all its landmarks. All students are expected to participate on the photo walk taking photographs at various points of interest. Students must wear appropriate footwear, as a matter of health and safety. Students who do not comply with this will not be able to take part. Students must bring a bottle of water to keep hydrated throughout the day.
