Requesting Leave of Absence for Eid ul-Adha

We are writing to you in advance to confirm the process for requesting a leave of absence for religious observance, as directed by the Department for Education.


All students celebrating Eid are entitled to request one day's leave for religious observance. Given that Eid celebrations may vary among our families, we ask that if you are celebrating on **Monday 11 July 2022**, you notify the school in the morning of your child's absence by one of the following:

Whilst we acknowledge the importance of family time on the day of Eid, we are duty-bound to ensure all students are appropriately accounted for, therefore your cooperation in this regard would be appreciated.

The school (once notified) will authorise leave for the day requested and your child's record will be updated. Parents/Carers are reminded that any absence following this day of religious observance will be marked as unauthorised. In the case of absence due to illness, the school may request medical evidence prior to authorising any absence.
