New Year 11 Grammar School Visit

Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child has been selected to attend a school visit to King Edwards Aston Grammar School.

The primary objective of this trip is to immerse pupils in a prestigious Grammar School environment, enhancing their awareness of post-16 options and educational qualifications. Pupils will develop communication skills through a Q&A session and participate in two specially planned lessons that illustrate the academic standards at a Grammar School known for its emphasis on challenge and excellence.

During the visit, pupils will tour the school, engage with school leaders, and learn about entry requirements, aiming to raise their aspirations. The lessons will be pitched at a higher academic level than they are accustomed to, providing valuable experience.
